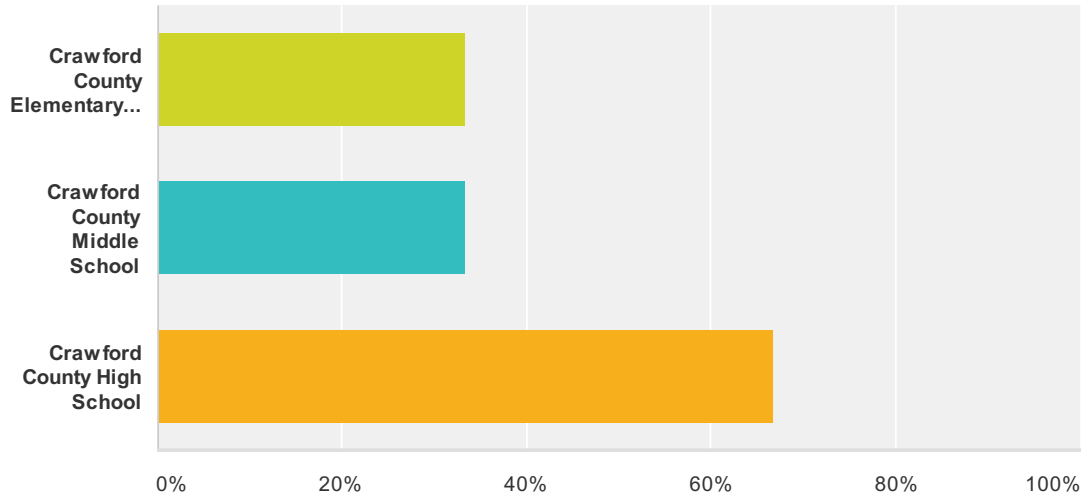

## Q1 What school does your child(ren) attend? (check all that apply)

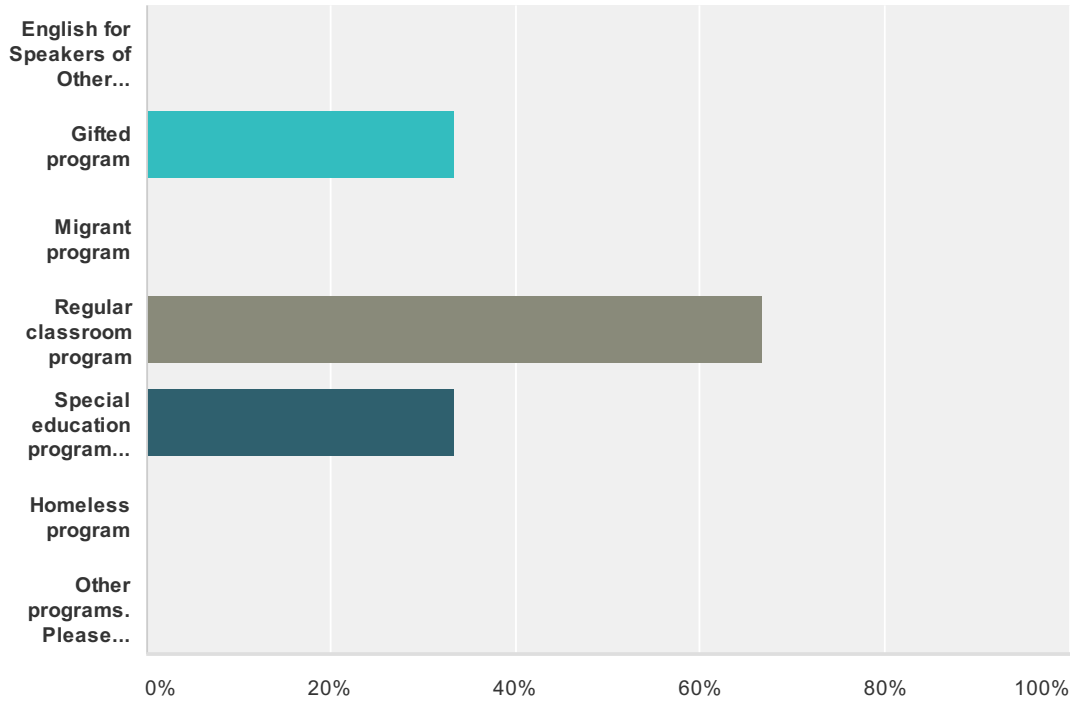

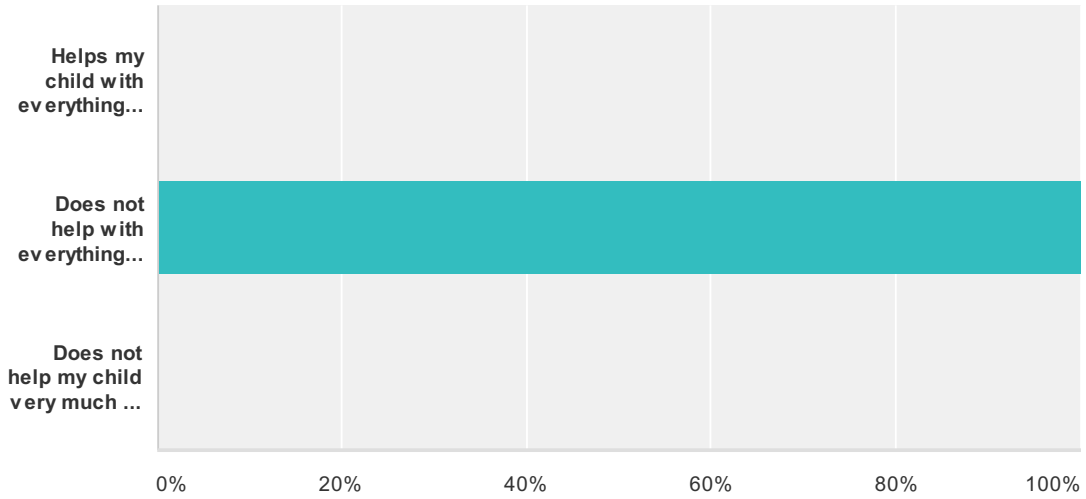

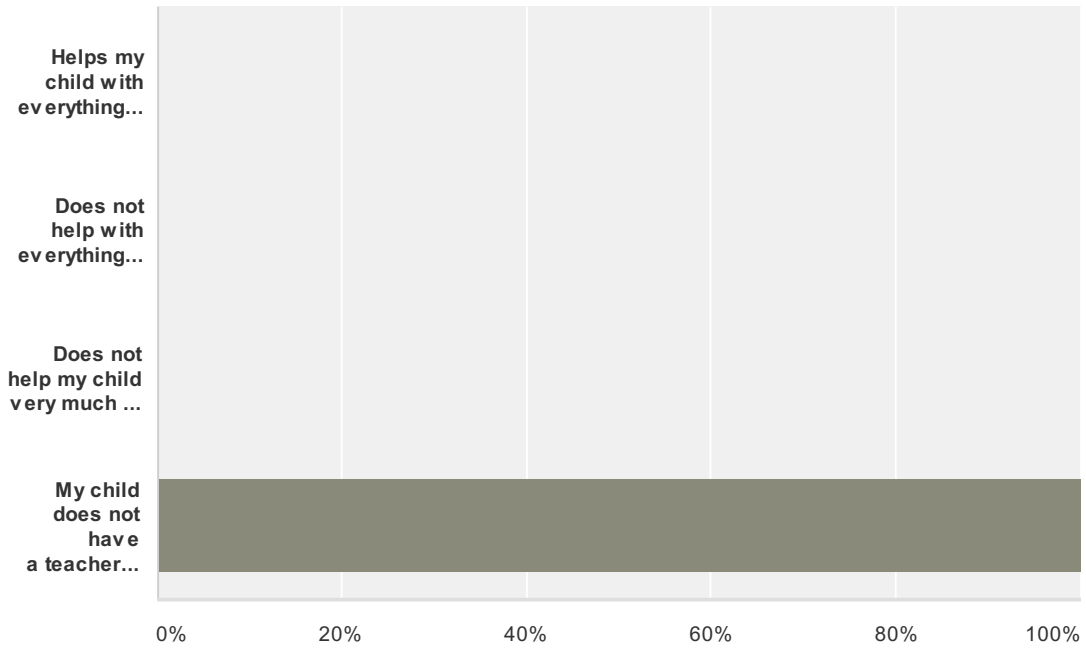

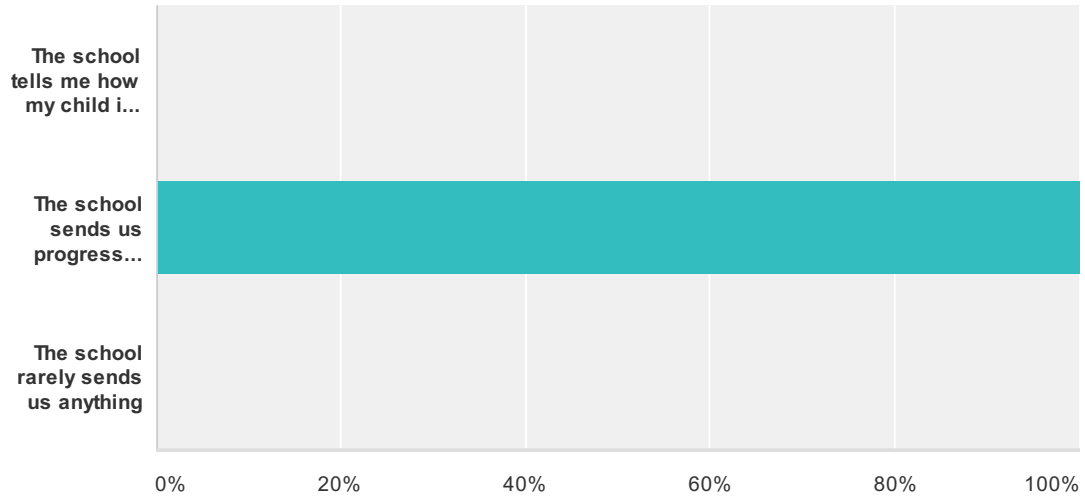

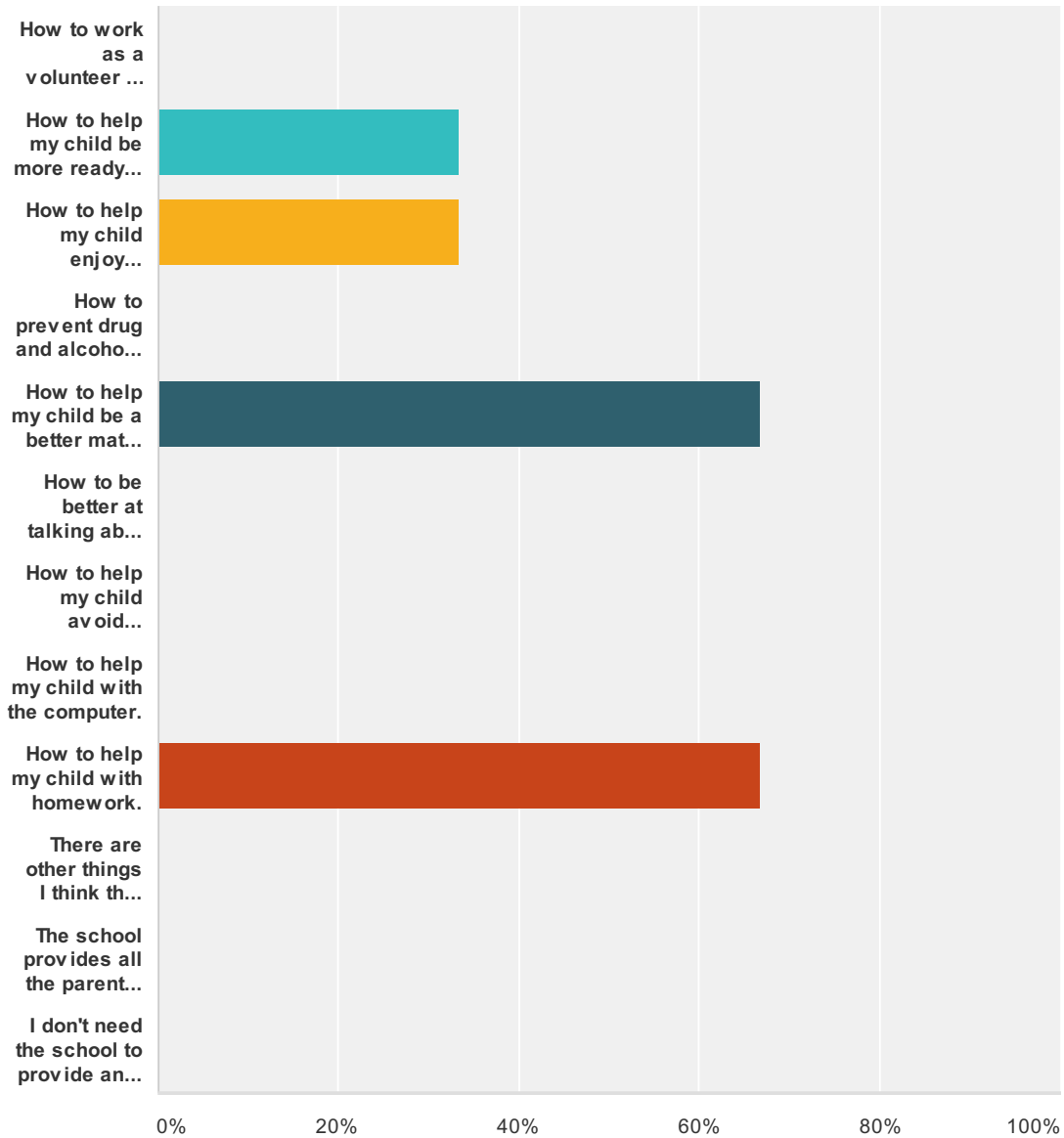
