How can you get involved?

- ✓ Talk to your child daily about school activities and experiences.
- ✓ Talk with teachers regularly even when no problems exist.
- ✓ Broaden your child's understanding of the world by visiting parks, zoos, sports stadiums, theaters, farms and local landmarks.
- ✓ Encourage children to count money; make shopping lists; calculate costs, sale prices and taxes; read menus and newspapers; and write letters.
- ✓ Designate a specific time and place for homework.
- ✓ Read to your child daily. Encourage independent reading. Visit the library.
- ✓ Set goals that are challenging, but attainable.
- ✓ Visit the school regularly and become involved in school activities.
- ✓ Be familiar with your child's curriculum and its required skills and goals.
- Be aware that your attitudes about school and teachers influence your child's attitudes.

Questions to ask before reading:

- What is the title of the book?
- What does the cover tell you about the book?
- What do you think the book is about?
- What are you curious to find out about this book?
- What do you already know about this book?
- What do you want to learn?
- Why are you reading this book?


Questions to ask during reading:

- What do you think will happen next?
- What is the problem in the book?
- Why do you think the character did that?
- When you were reading this part, what were you picturing in your head?

Questions to ask after reading:

- Describe the setting of the story.
- Describe how a character changed throughout the book. Which of the characters did you like best? Why?
- What were some of the problems or situations the characters encountered?
- Tell about a part that you liked or disliked and tell why?
