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## Developing Successful Readers

### By Our Kindergarten Teachers

- 📖 Reading = Bonding
- 📖 Reading to a child develops a successful reader.
- 📖 Reading develops vocabulary, helps with language and speech development.
- 📖 Let your child see you read.
- Ideas for Reading Time**
- 📖 Find a quiet and comfortable place to read.
- 📖 Introduce the book: read the title, author, illustrator; look at the cover; talk about what the book may be about.
- 📖 Run your finger under the text and pause at the end of the sentences.
- 📖 Ask questions about the book to increase the child's critical thinking skills.
- 📖 Ask the child to make predictions about what is going to happen in the book.
- 📖 Repeat interesting words and rhymes while reading.
- 📖 Pause and wait for the child to say repetitive or predictable phrases.
- 📖 Ask thinking questions: "What might happen next? Where did he go? Why did she do that?"
- 📖 Invite the child to talk, draw or pretend to be one of the characters.
- 📖 **LET YOUR CHILD READ TO YOU!!** Practice increases fluency.
- 📖 Read non-fiction books, as well as fiction. This increases their knowledge of the world we live in.

### Parent/Teacher Conferences

When teachers and parents communicate often and well, everybody wins, especially your child. The parent-teacher conference is an important way to build a relationship with your child's teacher. By listening intently, asking pointed questions, and being open to the teacher's point of view, you can gather the information you need to help your child have a smooth, successful year.
