## **CHAPTER 6.00 – HUMAN RESOURCES**

## **POLITICAL ACTIVITIES**

6.32

- I. School Board employees shall not solicit support for any political candidate or issue during regular work hours.
- II. A School Board employee who offers himself/herself as a candidate for public office shall conduct his/her campaign so as not to interfere with his/her responsibilities.
  - A. Such candidate shall adhere strictly to Alabama laws governing political activity on the part of public officials and public employees.
  - B. A successful candidate for an office requiring a part-time responsibility shall report immediately to the Superintendent after the election and thereafter, when deemed necessary by the Superintendent or the School Board, to evaluate the compatibility of the dual responsibility and the amount of time the employee will be absent. Under no circumstances will an employee who has been elected to public office be allowed to perform duties related to the public office while performing his/her duties for the school system.
