## Highlights

**Windham Elementary School** implemented *THE LEADER IN ME* based on the *7 HABITS OF HIGHLY EFFECTIVE PEOPLE*. *THE LEADER IN ME* equips students with the self-confidence and skills they need to thrive in the 21<sup>st</sup> century economy.



- According to 2012-2013 testing results, Windham Elementary School's 6<sup>th</sup> grade students are 99% proficient in reading.
- Windham has earned three National Awards as Renaissance Learning "Model Schools."

**Daleville City Schools** are a member of the Military Child Education Coalition. Daleville has an award winning Student 2 Student Program (S2S) that was chosen as one of the top four programs of 164 S2S programs in the world. The program provides:

**Daleville City School's** graduation rate ranks in the top ten in the state of Alabama.

**Daleville City School's** 2013 graduating Seniors were offered in excess of 1.3 million dollars in scholarships.

**The Daleville City Schools' Band Program** serves approximately 298 students grades 6-12.

The musicians themselves make up 38% of the school's population, while 45% of the school attends classes in the music department at some point during the school day.

- Two directors work together to team teach all of these ensembles.
- The band recently won the Heritage Festivals' concert and jazz competition in Orlando and was invited to perform at Carnegie Hall. Student led ensembles have also achieved success performing in the lobby at the 2012 and 2013 AMEA conferences.
- In 2012, the band had 21 students achieve the designation of becoming All-State bandmen and 42 students distinguished as members of the District VIII Honor Band.
- The school record for District Honor Band participation stands at 52.



**The Daleville City Schools' Sports Programs** excel in all athletic competition.



- The 2012-2013 football of Daleville High School went 10-0 in the regular season and were area champions
- The 2012-2013 boys' basketball team went 28-4 in the regular season and was the area champions.
- The 2012-2013 girls' basketball was the area champions, also.
- Daleville High School has an excellent sports program and has several former players that are or have participated at a higher level of sports, by way of scholarships, after graduation from Daleville.

**The Daleville High School's JROTC's** rifle team won the state championship for the sport air rifle class division, earned second place in the Army Service Championship and won third place in the Interservice National Championship in Anniston.



- The team also took home first place regionally in the Wiregrass Rifle Conference and won first place in the Buccaneer Open Air Rifle Match in Acworth, Ga.
- The rifle team has done an excellent job, and has placed within the top three teams in the nation for the last three years.
- The JROTC drill team is also an award-winning team.



A grant from The Department of Defense Education Activities (DoDEA) assisted the Daleville School System to purchase 21<sup>st</sup> Century technology for the classrooms. The second year evaluation of the grant indicated that the military connected students' proficiency score was on or above 90%.



Daleville City Schools have been awarded the "What Parents Want Award" for 18 consecutive years.
