Earn the honors distinction! Select the Alabama Southern Honors Program! Soar to new heights with your education!

As a student of Alabama Southern, you are invited to explore a new and exciting opportunity. Alabama Southern Community College now offers an honors option for most transfer classes. By selecting to participate in the Honors Program, you will be qualified to graduate with Honors Distinction, transfer your honors credits to the University of Alabama, and participate in a number of exciting learning experiences uniquely designed for you.

The Honors Program at Alabama Southern is designed to encourage motivated students to stretch academically. At Alabama Southern, students select which classes to take for Honors credit, and agree to fulfill an Honors Contract under the guidance of the instructor. The work completed under the contract offers interested, capable students opportunities to enrich the regular curriculum. Students also participate in an Honors Seminar which connects them to a community of peers who strive for excellence. Nationwide, students enrolled in Honors classes make better grades than their peers, and usually make higher grades in honors courses than they do in their regular classes.

How Can I Participate in the Honors Program?

- Complete an application. Applications are available at each campus in the Student Development Office.
- Register for and attend the Honors Forum

(IDS 115), which meets once a month during the semester on the Monroeville campus.

- Choose one or more courses that you want to transform into Honors courses, and meet with your instructor to develop a contract.
- Sign an Honors Contract with one or more of your instructors.

How will this benefit me?

- A once in a lifetime chance to participate in an honors program without needing a qualifying GPA or ACT or SAT score
- Opportunity to enhance your learning experiences and develop a deeper understanding of college level material
- Opportunity to network with scholars and professionals who can help guide your future
- Chance to meet and work with others who are as passionate about their education as you are
- Lifelong distinction of graduating from college with honors
- Privilege of wearing regalia specific to the honors program at graduation
- Ability to transfer your honors to many fouryear institutions and continue participation in their honors programs
- Opportunity to travel within the United States and abroad
- More competitive scholarship application to transfer institutions
- Creation of special college memories that will last forever
