Alabama Southern's welding training includes hands-on experience with various types of welding, cutting, and grinding as well as reading blueprints. The program begins with plate welding then covers pipe welding. Alabama Southern uses modern welding equipment to provide instruction in such skills as SMAW, GMAW, FCAW, GTAW and Oxyacetylene Cutting, Plasma Cutting and Carbon Arc Gouging.

Alabama Southern teaches more than just welding skills, we make sure you are prepared for the job by including instruction in work safety and encouragement in professional work practices and self discipline.

Welding Admission Requirements

- Students should be 16 and older with a high school diploma or GED. Students without a GED or high school diploma may enter the program after passing the Ability to Benefit Test.
- Students must complete Alabama Southern admissions application and submit official transcripts of all previous academic work to the office of Student Development.
- All students must take the COMPASS
 Placement Test for placement in English, math and reading.

Financial Aid

Financial Aid is available for most of our programs. Pell Grants are available for students who qualify. Students should apply for financial aid four to six weeks prior to planned date of enrollment.
