Lady Eagle Basketball Camp • \$75 • Ages 8 to 17 • June 8-10 • 9 am - 1 pm

Participants will focus on the development of fundamental skills such as shooting, passing and ball handling. A variety of games, relays, contests and competitions will also be held for the participants.

Eagle Baseball Camp • \$50 for both days or \$30 for one day • Ages 12 and under • June 10-11 • 9 am – 1 pm
