PLACEMENT TESTING INFORMATION

All new students are required to take the COMPASS placement test and participate in Student Orientation and Registration (SOAR) before registering for classes. The COMPASS placement test is designed to measure basic reading, writing, and math skills to help us determine the best initial course placement to ensure academic success. This is not a pass or fail test. While the COMPASS placement test is required of all students, there are some exceptions. The following students do not have to take the COMPASS test:

- Audit only students
- Transient students
- Students who have an associate degree or higher
- Students who transfer degree-creditable college-level English or math courses with a grade of "C" or above
- Senior citizens, undeclared, and other non-award seeking majors who are taking classes
- Students in certain short certificate programs having no English or mathematics requirements
- Students who have completed required developmental coursework at another Alabama College System institution within the last three years.
- Students who can provide documentation of COMPASS assessment within the last three years

Students scoring 20 or above on the ACT Reading and English and a 19 or above on ACT for Math who enroll in a System College within three years of high school graduation are exempt from the COMPASS placement test. However, students who want to be placed into a degree-creditable math course need to have scored a 22 or above on the ACT math test.

SCHEDULING A PLACEMENT TEST

Prospective students may schedule a time to take the placement test by calling Alabama Southern's Student Development Offices. Scheduling is designed to accommodate the prospective student, so convenient hours are offered, days and evenings. Students must present a valid picture ID when they arrive for testing.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

Alabama Southern offers several valuable scholarships for graduating seniors. All students who have received scholarship recognition are encouraged to apply. All scholarships have specific academic requirements, and some have special conditions to be met. You may apply in multiple scholarship categories, but only one scholarship will be awarded per student.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- **President's** Minimum ACT composite score of 28 and grade point average of 90/3.5. Pays \$10,000 plus books. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)
- Dean's Minimum ACT composite score of 24 and grade point average of 85/3.0. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)
- Academic Excellence Minimum ACT of 21 and grade point average of 80/2.5. Pays \$6,000. (\$3,000 a year for 2 years)

SELECTIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

- Ambassador Scholarship Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Interview process. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)
- Art Scholarship Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Required to produce a portfolio of their work. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)
- Music Scholarship Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Required to audition with Music Director. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)
- Theater Scholarship Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Required to audition with Theater Director. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)
- Technical Scholarship Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Interview process.

Areas in which you can earn a technical scholarship:

Cosmetology, Machine Tool Technology, Business Technology, Industrial Maintenance, Instrumentation/Electronics and Paper and Chemical Technology. Pays \$6,000. (\$3,000 a year for 2 years) (\$3,000 only for 1-year certificate programs)
