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This form is to be used by high school students who are applying for the Accelerated High School Student Program in area school systems and Alabama Southern Community College.

Eligible students are permitted to enroll in college courses conducted during school hours, after school hours, and during summer terms. Courses offered shall be drawn from Alabama Southern's existing academic inventory of courses for credit. Courses numbered below 100 and physical education courses are not eligible under this plan. Alabama Southern reserves the right to cancel course offerings when courses do not meet minimum enrollment requirements.

To be eligible for the accelerated high school student program, each student must meet the following criteria:

1. Meet the admission requirements of Alabama Southern Community College.
2. Successfully complete the 10th grade.
3. Complete any required high school prerequisites (for example, a student may not take English Composition until all required high school English courses have been completed). You must have appropriate scores on the ACT or the ASSET/COMPASS placement test.
4. The local principal or his/her designee must certify that the student has a minimum cumulative "B" average and recommend that the student be admitted to this program. A letter must be submitted each semester the student attends the college.
5. Exception may be made to requirements one and two above for students documented as gifted and talented according to the standards included in the State Plan of Exceptional Children and Youth. Permission must be obtained from the Chancellor of the Alabama College System.

Students who attend a non-accredited high school must meet additional criteria as listed below:

1. Must meet requirement 1,2, and 3 as stated above.
2. **Provide ACT scores** with a composite of at least 16 or above.
