We are excited to announce an expansion of the Presidential Scholarship Program for the graduating students of Alabama Southern Community College beginning the 2014-15 academic year. This scholarship will pay in-state tuition costs for fall and spring up to twelve hours each semester (24 semester hours per academic year). The scholarship is renewable for one additional year with continued academic progress at the 3.5 grade point average.

To be eligible for the scholarship Jacksonville State University requires that your student graduate prior to Fall 2014, be unconditionally accepted to Jacksonville State University, apply for this scholarship prior to March 1, 2014, have an overall 3.5 grade point average (GPA) and have never attended Jacksonville State University as a full-time student.

This program expands the Presidential Transfer Scholarships to Jacksonville State University which were limited in number. The program is unlimited with regard to eligible students from Alabama Southern Community College.
