Alabama Southern Community College evaluates scholarship applications as they are received. These scholarships are designated to graduating high school seniors. All scholarships are based on the applicant's academic record, ability and/or leadership achievement or capability. Automatic scholarships will be awarded after December 1 deadline and selective scholarships will be awarded after February 15 deadline.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

Alabama Southern offers several valuable scholarships for graduating seniors. All students who have received scholarship recognition are encouraged to apply. All scholarships have specific academic requirements, and some have special conditions to be met. You may apply in multiple scholarship categories, but only one scholarship will be awarded per student. Scholarship evaluation begins February 15. Scholarships are evaluated in the order in which they are received. To receive priority status students should apply for scholarships by December 1.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS President's – Minimum ACT composite score of 28 and grade point average of 90/3.5. Pays \$10,000 plus books. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)			
☐ Dean's – Minimum ACT composite score of 24 and grade point average of 85/3.0. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)			
☐ Academic Excellence – Minimum ACT of 21 and grade point average of 80/2.5. Pays \$6,000. (\$3,000 a year for 2 year)			
SELECTIVE SCHOLARSHIPS Ambassador Scholarship – Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Interview process. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)			
☐ Art Scholarship – Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Required to produce a portfolio of their work. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)			
☐ Music Scholarship – Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Required to audition with Music Director. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)			
☐ Theater Scholarship – Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Required to audition with Theater Director. Pays \$10,000. (\$5,000 a year for 2 years)			
☐ Technical Scholarship – Minimum grade point average of 80/2.5. Interview process. Areas in which you can earn a technical scholarship: Cosmetology, Machine Tool Technology, Business Technology, Industrial Maintenance, Instrumentation/Electronics and Paper and Chemical Technology. Pays \$6,000. (\$3,000 a year for 2 years) (\$3,000 only for 1-year certificate programs)
