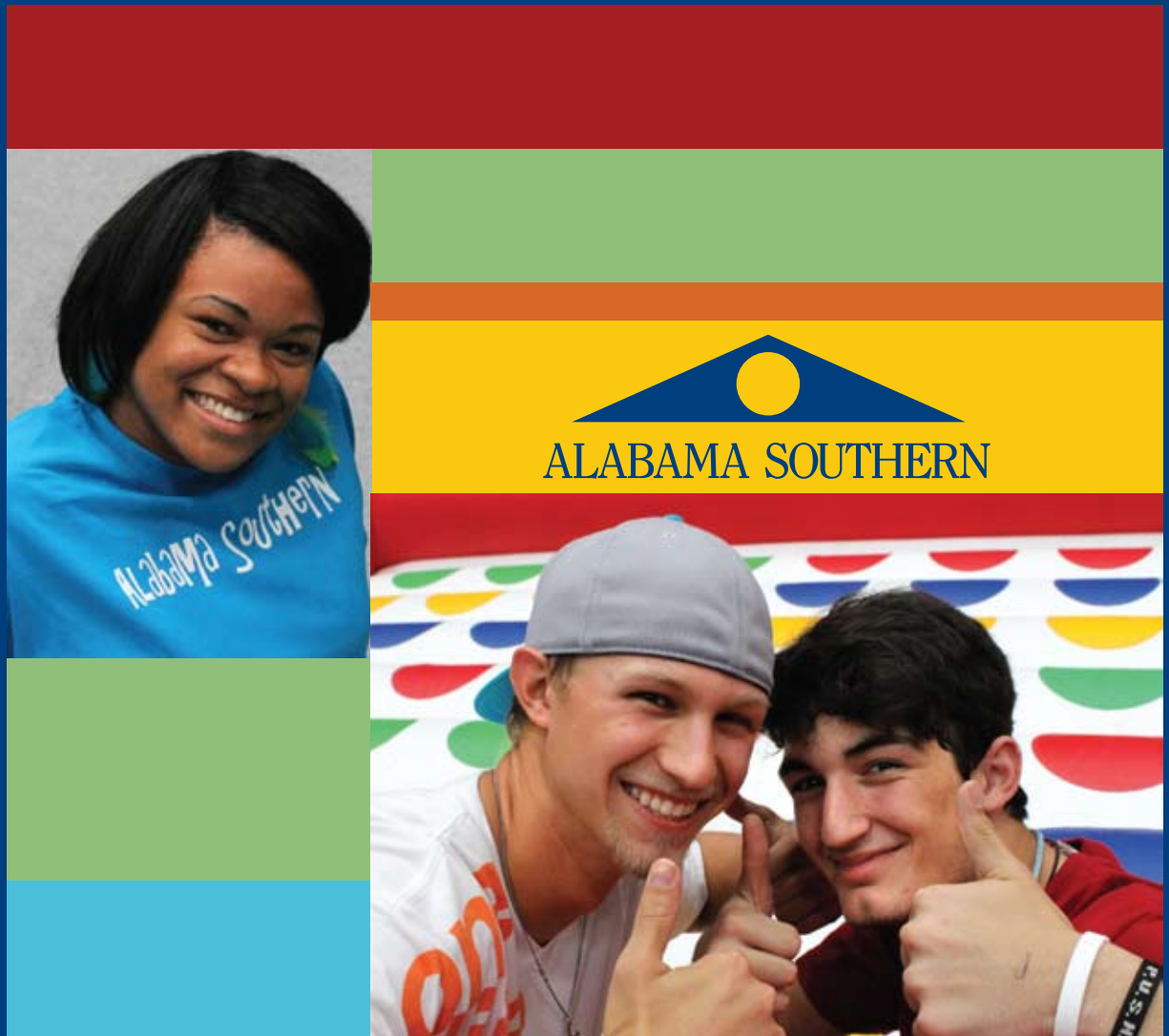

- Computers are available to students in classrooms, computer labs and libraries.



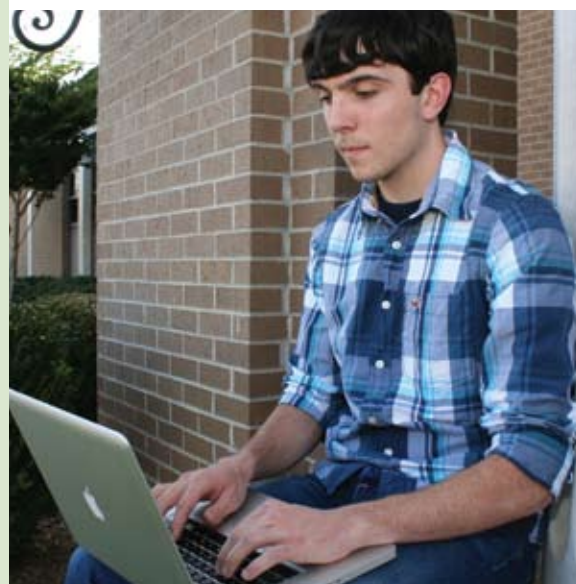
11 EASY STEPS to enroll in Alabama Southern

- 1 Apply for Admission.** Submit your application, high school transcript, GED documentation and/or official transcripts from all other colleges attended to the Registrar's office. You must also submit a completed residency verification form and submit your photo ID in person or a notarized copy by mail.
- 2 Apply for Financial Aid.** Submit your application and financial documentation to the Financial Aid office.
- 3 Take the COMPASS Placement Test.** The COMPASS Placement Test is required of all new degree seeking or vocational/occupational students and any transfer student who has not had an English or mathematics course and wishes to take one.
- 4 Attend SOAR (Student Orientation and Registration).** Dates will be posted on www.ascc.edu prior to the start of each semester.
- 5 See an Advisor & Select Classes.** An advisor in your major will assist you in selecting classes and in helping you complete a class schedule.
- 6 Register for Classes.** After you meet with your advisor you will be cleared for online registration through ASCC Online.
- 7 Obtain Parking Permit.** Parking permits are issued during registration. Students must complete a Vehicle Registration Card to receive a parking permit. Parking permits are valid for two years.
- 8 Pay Tuition and Fees.** All tuition and fees must be paid at the time you register. Registration is not complete without this important step.
- 9 Purchase Books & Supplies.** Take your schedule of classes to the bookstore and personnel will assist you. Pell Grant and scholarship students who wish to charge books may purchase books the first day of class.
- 10 Student Photo ID.** Take your schedule of classes and your photo ID to the library to have your student ID made. Student IDs are required and can also be used at local merchants for discounts.
- 11 Attend class and have a wonderful semester!**

Required Documents for Admission

- High school diploma or GED
- Alabama Southern admissions application
- Official transcripts from all other colleges attended

The first two years of any four-year major can be completed at Alabama Southern. Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees require two years to complete. Alabama Southern has developed a university transfer guide with curricula that correspond to the first two years of various majors at senior institutions. FINANCIAL AID TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

Financial aid is available for almost every program offered at Alabama Southern, and our friendly financial aid staff can help you secure the aid you need to pay for college. Visit the Financial Aid office when you apply for admission. Students should apply for financial aid four to six weeks prior to planned date of enrollment in order to know their financial aid status before school starts.

Steps to apply for Financial Aid

- 1** Complete a free application for Federal Student Aid online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Allow two to three weeks for the application process.
- 2** Submit an Institutional Application to the financial aid office. The Institutional Application is available online at www.ascc.edu or in the Student Development Office.
- 3** Submit all additional documentation, verification, corrections and/or new information requested by either the financial aid office or the agency determining the student's eligibility.

Scholarships

Scholarships are available for graduating high school seniors in the following categories: Academic, Ambassador, Performing Arts, Leadership and Technical. Scholarship priority deadline is December 15, and the final deadline is February 15. To apply for a scholarship, the following information must be submitted as a complete application packet to the Alabama Southern Recruiter, located on the Monroeville campus:

- Completed Scholarship Application (found at www.ascc.edu)
- Completed Application for Admission
- A legible copy of the applicant's academic transcript with attendance section completed
- Verification of applicant's ACT score when applicable

Scholarships are also available for athletics, Industry Alliance and returning/non-traditional students.

- **Out-of-State Rate:** The tuition rate for out-of-state students is \$218 per credit hour.

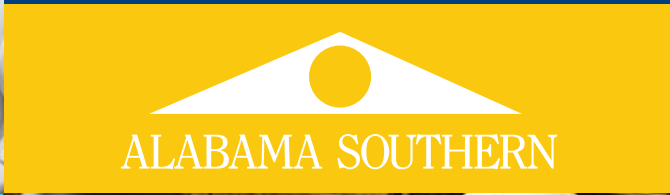
For online courses
