Dear Parents:

The current Mississippi Immunization law states "All students entering the 7th grade must have documentation from a physician verifying that they have received a recent Tdap vaccination (at age 7 or later). This includes new students, current students, and transfer students." Due to this requirement, we are **now requiring a new Certificate of Immunization (Form 121) on each student entering the 7th grade. The Form 121 must have all previous shots listed on it, as well as, the Tdap booster that is required. All of this must be on one form. Desoto County Schools will only accept Form 121s that are typed or computer printed (hand written forms will not be accepted) and signed by a Mississippi physician or Health Department. We cannot accept a Form 121 signed by a Tennessee doctor or clinic due to different immunization requirements in each state.**

You can bring the new completed Form 121 to the school as soon as you get it; you do not have to wait until summer registration.

We wanted to give you advance notice of this, so you would have time to take your child and get the required vaccination and paperwork. Please do not wait until the last minute. Students will not be allowed to attend the first day of class in August without the proper immunizations and form.
