In accordance with Governor Abbott's Executive Order issued yesterday, Driscoll ISD will extend the timeline for our school closures through May 1, 2020. The earliest we would return to school would be Monday, May 4th.

We will review our reopening plans the week of April 27th. We will also continue to align our decisions with guidance from the local, state and national government and health agencies.

Driscoll ISD will continue supporting our students' learning via Zoom, Google Classroom and/or instructional packets, and we plan to continue providing meals every Monday and Thursday for pickup at our curbside location throughout the duration of the closure.

We understand the impact of the district's sustained closure on our families, staff and community. We truly appreciate your continued patience and support as we continue to work as swiftly and effectively as possible to support you all during this challenging time.
