

MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS AND REGISTRATION
EAST UNION COMMUNITY SCHOOL
"2016-2017"

REGISTRATION: Students must register any vehicle/s which they might drive to and from school. Registration forms must be signed by parent/guardian, student and turned in for administrative approval. Registration should be completed prior to driving to school, but **MUST** be completed within **one week** of the students' first day of driving to school.

PARKING: Students will park on the north side of the building or football field. Students shall **NOT** park in the handicapped stall or any other are not assigned to them.

LIABILITY: Students who drive a vehicle to school will assume full responsibility for all happenings related to the vehicle is not the responsibility of the school.

LOSS OF PRIVILEGE: Driving to school is a "privilege, not a right". A student who violates school policy relating to vehicles and driving to school will be subject to disciplinary measures which may include suspension of the privilege to drive any vehicle on school property.

SPECIAL MINOR'S LICENSE - SUMMARY

THIS LICENSE CAN BE ISSUED TO A MINOR DRIVER IF THEY MEET THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED BELOW. THE STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN MUST MEET WITH THE SECONDARY PRINCIPAL OR THE SUPERINTENDENT, BY APPOINTMENT, AND BRING THEIR DRIVER'S EDUCATION COMPLETION CERTIFICATE AND THEIR LEARNER'S PERMIT TO OBTAIN A SCHOOL PERMIT.

1. The minimum age to be eligible for a minor school license (MSL) is 14 ½.
2. The student must have completed an Iowa-approved course in driver education unless exempted because of hardship as defined by Iowa Administrative Code 761-602.26(3).
3. The student must have held a valid Instruction Permit during the six-month period immediately preceding application for the MSL.
4. The student's driving history must be free of convictions for moving traffic violations, contributive accidents and license withdrawals during the six-month period immediately preceding application.
5. The student must live one mile or more from the school of enrollment.
6. The Iowa DOT issues the MSL and may require a drive test.
7. The MSL can be used during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. There are no exceptions or waivers of the time period when driving on an MSL.
8. The student can drive over the most direct and accessible route between the licensee's residence and school(s) of enrollment and between schools of enrollment for the purposes of attending duly scheduled courses of instruction. The MSL may also be used to travel to and from extracurricular activities within the school district.
9. Use of the MSL is limited to the school district of residence of the parent or guardian of the student. However, it may also be used to drive to a contiguous (bordering) district if the student is enrolled in the public school which is not the school district of residence because of open enrollment under Iowa Code Section 282.18, or as a result of an election by the student's district of residence to enter into one or more sharing agreements pursuant to the procedures in Chapter 282, Code of Iowa.
10. The statute allows driving to and from the licensee's residence. The official residence would seem to be with the parent who has primary custody. Anything beyond that would be a local decision made by the school district. Advice should be given by local law enforcement and the county attorney.
11. The MSL can be suspended for reasons other than a conviction. The DOT may also suspend an MSL when it receives written notice from a peace officer, parent, custodian or guardian, school superintendent, or superintendent's designee that the student has violated the restrictions of the MSL. The MSL may also be suspended under the remedial driver improvements improvement provisions of Iowa's Graduated Driver Licensing Law and suspended due to a contributive accident.
12. The statute that governs the MSL does not authorize or prohibit passengers. The DOT's position is that passengers are allowed only if they enter the vehicle at the licensee's home and exit the vehicle at the same destination as the driver. No stops along the way to pickup or discharge passengers.
13. The statute that governs the MSL does not authorize or prohibit stopping for fuel. Since obtaining fuel is incidental to driving, the DOT's position is that it is allowed providing the service station is on the most direct and accessible route.
