At Enterprise Elementary School, our goal is to provide a successful learning environment for all students. We encourage all parents to take an active role in their child's education.

Parental Involvement Plan

- I. Enterprise Elementary School encourages parental participation in all school programs with emphasis on Title I planning and implementation. Parents will receive a survey annually to make recommendations for the educational needs of their child.
- II. A schoolwide planning team will meet several times each year to review and evaluate current programs and plans. The planning team will consist of administrators, teachers, parents, and community members.
- III. An annual Title Parent Meeting will be held to inform parents of Title I participation, its requirements, and their right to be involved.
- IV. A School-Parent Compact describing the collaborative effort and commitment from all involved parties will be discussed during Open House.
- V. Parent meetings and conferences will be held throughout the school year to discuss programs for our students. Administrators, teachers, parents, and community members are encouraged to attend the meetings and give input on the discussed activities.

- VI. Newsletters and Monthly Activity Calendars will be sent out once a month to inform parents of important dates and events happening in the school and classroom. Activities will be posted weekly in the *Clarke County Tribune*.
- VII. Progress reports will be sent home to parents halfway through each nine-week period. At the end of each nine-week period, teachers will send report cards home to parents. Grades on report cards will reflect mastery of the Mississippi Curriculum Frameworks.
- VIII. During the fall, student assessment information will be disseminated to parents with written explanation for interpretation. The principal will be accessible to explain assessment results.
- IX. Enterprise Elementary School encourages parent/teacher conferences. Parents can call the school and schedule conferences with teachers.
- X. Enterprise Elementary School promotes an open-door policy. Parents may check in with the office staff to visit the campus.
- XI. Kindergarten teachers and the principal will work collaboratively with pre-K providers to encourage a smooth transition to kindergarten.
