LATE PICK-UP POLICY

All members are to be picked up by closing time. Any child not picked-up by closing will be charged \$5 every 15 minutes after the time of closing (this time is measured in 7 minute increments). This late charge must be paid prior to the child returning to the Club. Children left at the Club for an extended time after it has closed will be turned over to the proper authorities. Also, no child should be dropped off at the Club prior to its opening.

SUMMER PROGRAM

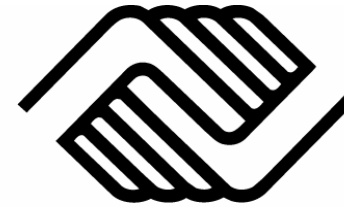

Every day, our Club strives to fulfill its mission of enabling young people to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens. Our goal is to engage youth at a deeper level in the fun, positive environment of a Boys & Girls Club while having an impact on children in three priority areas:

Academic Success: members are being promoted to the next grade level by participating in programs such as Homework Help, Kid’s College, Career Launch, and Project Learn.

Character & Citizenship: members become engaged citizens involved in their community and model strong character through participation in Club programs such as Keystone & Torch Clubs.

Healthy Lifestyles: members adopt a healthy diet, practice healthy choices and make lifelong commitments to fitness through participation in programs such as Healthy Habits, Triple Play, Smart Moves, Smart Girls and Passport to Manhood.

AGES & FEES

Any youth or teen between the ages of 6 and 18 may join the Club. The annual membership fee for youth 12 and younger is \$30: \$10 for each school session and \$10 for the summer. For teens, membership is \$20 annually, \$10 for the school year and \$10 for the summer. There are additional fees for special programs.

HOURS

Our hours of operation during the school year are Monday through Friday every day immediately after school until 6 PM for our elementary school students and until 7 PM for our teen students. Our hours during the Christmas & Spring Breaks and other non-school days are 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM. Saturdays are reserved for special programs.

Boys & Girls Club Code of Conduct

Always show respect for yourself, others and the Boys & Girls Club.

If you have a problem, or have a question; ask a staff member.

Follow staff directions at all times and follow member expectations for each program area.

On school days, a child must have attended school that day to attend the club.

Use on the front door when entering or leaving the club.

Members and visitors must sign in at the front desk daily.

Parents must come into the building to pick up their child(ren).

You are responsible for your personal belongings.

Club members are asked not to bring games, personal items and large sums of money to the Club. The Club will not be responsible for lost or damaged items.

Keep your hands and feet to yourself.

Use appropriate language at all times.

No hats in the building; no sagging or short shorts.

The club telephone is for emergency use only.

Cell phones are not to be used on club property. Phones & other electronic devices will be confiscated and returned only to the child’s parent.

Alcohol, tobacco, or drugs are not permitted on Club property or at Club sponsored events.

Staff determines what is deemed appropriate in regards to behavior, language, and appearance.

Not following the Code of Conduct can result in immediate suspension from the club.
