COVID VACCINES AVAILABLE AT TALQUIN ELECTRIC May 28, 2021

Talquin has partnered with the Florida Department of Emergency Management to offer vaccines on-site at our Member Services offices in Quincy, Lake Jackson, Crawfordville, and Bradfordville.

Appointments are not required, but the vaccine distribution will be open to the general public, so be aware that there may be a small line at any given time.

The Florida Department of Emergency Management is offering the 2-dose Pfizer vaccine (age 12+ with parental consent) and the 1-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine (18+ years old). For those who choose the Pfizer vaccine, they should commit to both dates to ensure they receive both doses.

Both vaccines are free of charge to participants, but the Florida Department of Emergency Management is encouraging everyone to bring their insurance card so they can charge the insurance carriers when possible.
