Unless a specific policy has been amended and the date of the policy was revised is noted at the bottom of that policy, the bylaws and policies of The School Board of Gadsden County were adopted on June 25, 2013, and were in effect beginning June 26, 2013.

2440 - SUMMER SCHOOL

The School Board may conduct a summer program of academic instruction for students in kindergarten through grade twelve (12) for remediation in Math, English, Science, and Social Studies and those ESE students needing extended school year service, as identified in their I.E.P., at the K-12 level, for resident students of this District, and other students as approved. In addition to the 9-12 remedial and K-12 exceptional student education summer program, the District may choose to implement summer enhancement programs, contingent upon Board approval.

Summer school instruction shall be designed to provide opportunities for students to make up courses in which they received a "D" or "F", address ESE student I.E.P. needs, provide opportunities for remediation, and provide appropriate services for drop-out prevention students.

With regard to transportation, the Board accepts responsibility for full-time ESE students.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for developing administrative procedures for the operation of the summer program that shall be consistent with Board policies and not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of the District.
