2. Financial Information

Mrs. Wood stated that the cafeteria at Gadsden County High School was being remodeled. She stated that the old furniture in the cafeteria was being moved to Carter Parramore Academy. She stated that bonuses for GCCTA members were distributed last week. She stated that the districts total assessments for PAEC / Gateway budget without credits were \$71,992.69, and with credits were 68,778.40. She stated that the ISCORP Hosting amount was \$8,401.08. She stated that the district will soon be able to see how much is being spent in the school athletic accounts. She stated that Skyward training is held weekly for office managers. She stated that the district will have one vendor list. She stated that the district is working to stay in compliance with IRS regulations when working non employees at games. She stated that employee benefit booklets will be available to employees. She shared information with the Board regarding the number of hired employees (FTE) by center and funding source as of May 22, 2018.
