We have just completed a "preliminary run" of the up-coming 2013 tax roll. While the "Official Estimate" of your "total taxable value" is not due until June 1, 2013, I thought I might give each of you a heads-up on what the coming year has in store for your jurisdiction.

It seems that the loses are in the 1 to 2% range across the board with the exception of Gretna which had a small increase. We do not expect these percentages to change very much over the course of our reevaluation procedure. These losses should be "manageable" if your start working on your budget now.
