

The Children in Our Community

Gateway Early Head Start and Head Start Programs served more than 2,528 families and 2,599 infants, toddlers, and preschool children throughout an eight county area in 2016.

Gateway has maintained 100% enrollment in six counties, with 95% enrollment in Atlantic and Cape May Counties.

Due to limited funding, Gateway was only able to serve 10% of the eligible children in its service area with more than 23,000 served in other settings or remaining unserved.



In addition to supporting children's education, Gateway works with families to ensure children have medical and dental service available. Of the children served in Early Head Start and Head Start, 98% had health insurance. Nearly 70% were up-to-date with well child visits, with nearly 96% current with required immunizations. More than 74% of children had a dental home, an overall increase of 17% since children were enrolled in Gateway's Early Head Start and Head Start programs.




Gateway and Families Working together to Ensure School Readiness

Gateway partners with six school districts to provide early education services. Children with disabilities are identified and served through the joint efforts of local child study teams, early intervention programs, and Gateway's multi-disciplinary team.
