Bus Service Description

The Greater Bridgeton Area Transit program provides the opportunity for the community residents to have access to employment, medical, social services, shopping, general well-being and other activities.

The bus service runs from 6:00 am until 6:00 pm Monday through Friday and from 6:00 am until 3:30 pm on Saturdays and connects with NJ Transit services.

Fixed Route Service

The service operated is a "deviated fixed route service" and operates on a designated bus route. When time allows, the bus can deviate from its fixed route and stop at another locations.
