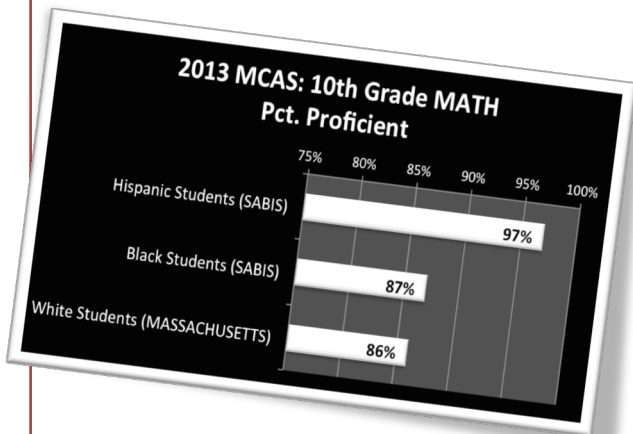

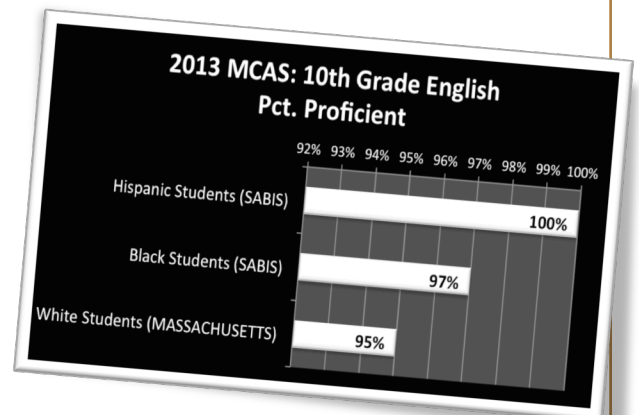
CLOSING ACHIEVEMENT GAPS: MATH

Hispanic and Black students attending the SABIS International Charter School in Springfield, MA, outperform their White student peers Statewide. Massachusetts is the highest performing state in the country. Hispanic 10th graders beat the state's White students by 11 percentage points on the State's MCAS math exam.



CLOSING ACHIEVEMENT GAPS: ENGLISH

By the 10th grade, Hispanic and Black students attending the SABIS International Charter School in Springfield, MA, outperform the state's White students on the state's MCAS exam. SABIS' Hispanic students achieved 100% proficiency in English!
