- Develop and implement developmentally appropriate literacy lessons aligned with both SC State Standards and the Montessori philosophy
- Organize units of study using the ELA/Writing/R2S standards

- Attend all required Read to Succeed workshops

- Use an approved assessment to measure literacy progress both school-wide and with specific students

Literacy Coach Secondary Functions:

- Perform all duties as assigned by the designated supervisor
- Act as a resource and information liaison to classroom teachers and school staff
- Attend and participate at staff meetings
- Attend open houses and other school functions
