Located in picturesque Pawleys Island, South Carolina, Coastal Montessori Charter School is an authentic Montessori school and the only charter school in Georgetown County. We currently have 241 students (264 capacity) enrolled in grades 1 - 8 and will enter our seventh year of operation in the 2018-2019 school year, operating in a modern, well-equipped building.
