The 2014-2015 School Year was extremely successful for Georgetown County School District.

We earned an "Excellent" Absolute Rating on the state Report Card for the third consecutive year. Also, this year our hard work was rewarded with an "Excellent" Improvement Rating, marking the first time GCSD has earned an "Excellent-Excellent" Report Card. Only seven of South Carolina's 82 school districts earned an "Excellent-Excellent" Report Card. The district's success is the result of our students, parents, teachers, and community members working together to provide the best possible education for all of our students.

We continue to offer a variety of rigorous course offerings in all of our high schools. Students earned \$12,783,547 in scholarships for this year's senior class, which is more than two million dollars more than the previous year.

Implementing many reading/writing, "flipped classrooms" strategies, district-wide partnership with Horry Georgetown Technical College (PACE), STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) Programs, along with our outstanding BEACH (Gifted and Talented Academic and Artistic Programs) have been just some of the innovations which have accelerated our performance.


