Sadie Grice Funny was born and raised in Georgetown, S.C. She and her husband nurtured and educated 11 children in the Plantersville area of the county. Sadie was committed to ensuring that all of her offspring's had the chance and resources to pursue any level of education they desired, which she knew would open the doors of opportunity and success to each of them.

Along with teaching her children the value of education, Sadie taught them the importance of being an entrepreneur and giving back to the community. When a transportation need arose in her community, Sadie established her own car and bus transit service to assist local workers needing transportation to and from Myrtle Beach. When she discovered that businesses needed employees, Sadie formed an employment referral service to notify individuals within the local communities of employment opportunities at businesses (hotels, restaurants, golf courses, churches, etc.) in Myrtle Beach.

Sadie was a devoted Christian who dedicated herself to service and excellence throughout her entire life. Having lived a full and successful life, Sadie made her transition to be with God in 1999. Three years later, her youngest son, John J. Funny, founded the Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship, in loving memory to his mother. The nonprofit foundation saluted Sadie for being a loving wife, devoted mother, sincere friend, dedicated church member, dynamic businesswoman, skillful negotiator, selfless humanitarian, creative visionary, promoter of justice, and above all, gracious woman of God. The Foundation celebrates Sadie's zest for life, commemorates her value of education, and immortalizes her contribution to the community for the success and prosperity of future generations.

Through academic funding, the Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation provides a financial resource to further the pursuit of educational objectives by eligible students. Since its establishment seven years ago, the Sadie Grice Funny Scholarship Foundation has bestowed more than \$88,000 in scholarships to promising students.
