Intermediate School Principal's Report

Principal Lauri Mapes presented the following information:

- Enrollment Currently 375
- School Theme for 2013-14 is "I CAN", which stands for Create, Achieve, and Navigate.



- Through the use of the "I CAN" Reading Bus, students are encouraged to read. One Saturday a month, the Reading Bus travels its preplanned bus route searching for students who are seen outside reading. Students are invited to travel on the bus, which takes them to a surprise location where they read, have a snack, and participate in a "Read Around" of the signs, etc. at the location.
- Multi-Media Class A 2 hour technology related class for 4th & 5th graders meeting on Mondays taught by Donna Fowler.
- Read Around the Planet The Intermediate Campus will participate in "Read Around the Planet" February 24-March 7, 2014. Classrooms use interactive video to connect with a classroom from a different location in the world and exchange reading activities.

Assistant Superintendent's Report, Tommy Gibson

- Utilities Usage Report (2011-12 compared to 2012-13):
 - Gas: District Cost Savings of \$9,084.87
 - Electricity: District Cost Savings of \$83,483.08
 - Water: 5.3 million gallons saved, however due to rate increases, District Cost Increase of \$2,929.
 - A 6-Yr Electricity Usage/Costs Summary reflects that over a 6 year period from 2007-08 to 2012-13, the district has significantly decreased its facility usage of electricity resulting in a \$396,353 savings.

Superintendent's Report

Enrollment

• Enrollment as of Friday, November 20 was 1,656. This is an increase of 43 from the first day of instruction and a decrease of 29 students from the corresponding day in 2012.

District and Campus Activities

- Lady Tigers volleyball team were runners-up in District 7-3A. They defeated Burnet in Bi-District and lost to Springtown in the Area round.
- The Tigers football team is the top seed in Division II 3A playoffs. They defeated Llano in Bi-District and will play Graham in the Area round on Friday, November 22nd at Mineral Wells.

• Glen Rose Intermediate hosted the 7-3A Elementary Academic UIL Meet. The Intermediate staff did an outstanding job hosting the Meet and the students did an outstanding job competing.

Employee Attendance Incentive

- As of the end of the second six weeks, the Weighted Average Daily Attendance is 2,087.925, a decrease in WADA of 49.075 from the district's budgeted WADA. This equates to a loss in revenue of \$358,787.
- Also, the net state/local revenue is down \$357,790 as of the end of the second six weeks, which is roughly equivalent to the loss in WADA.
- Budgeted recapture (the amount sent back to the state for Robin Hood) totaled \$11,366,667 but recapture through the end of the second six weeks totaled \$11,594,411, an increase of \$227,744.
- Mr. Rotan will continue to monitor and will update the Board on the district's finances regarding the availability of the Incentive.

- d. No Child Left Behind Qualified Teacher Report As of September 16, 2013, the district's HQ status reflects that three of four campuses were reported as achieving 100% highly qualified status. The Intermediate campus was reported as 97% compliant. The District requested and received approval of an emergency permit from TEA on behalf of the teacher that will expire on 08/31/14. Parents of the students in the bilingual class have been notified in writing that the teacher assigned does not meet the Federal requirements of highly qualified.
