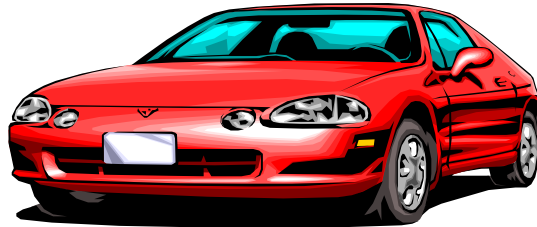


DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

2017 SUMMER CLASS SCHEDULE



Students must have their learner's permit by the first day of class. 30 hours of classroom instruction is required – make sure you can attend all class days before deciding on class dates that you would best fit your schedule.

Any class days missed, must be made up during a future class. The 6 hours of driving time will be scheduled on an individual basis, based on each student's schedule and availability.

Classes are open to any student that has their learner's permit – regardless of where they go to school.

Classes will be either at Gordon Central HS or Sonoraville HS. All Gordon County schools will be closed on Fridays during the summer break. As a result, the classroom classes will be 4 days long - 8 hours per day - from 8:00 until 4:00 each day. A 30 minute lunch break will be taken around 12:00 noon each day.

Class Schedule

At GCHS: June 1, 2, 5 and 6

(Students will need to bring paper and pencil / pen to each class. They will also need to bring their learner's permit with them.)

Cost: \$ 250

A non-refundable deposit of \$50 will need to be turned in with the application and the balance will be due on the first day of class.

However, the application should be turned in 1 week ahead of the class date. Classes that do not have the minimum number of students will be cancelled. If the class that you request is cancelled, you will be notified by phone or e-mail.

The application and deposit can be dropped off at either school (see Ms. Steward at GC or Ms. White at SHS) or at the Transportation Dept. on Dews Pond Road (see Robin Wilson or Mr. Keith Brown).
