

Does your child need good, affordable health insurance?
TennCare may be able to help!

Many children and teens are eligible for TennCare. Your child may be one of them, even if you work. Apply at your local DHS office

Follow these steps.

1. Department of Human Services (DHS)

- In the state of Tennessee, local DHS offices take applications for TennCare and other programs. All 95 counties have a DHS office.
 - Greene County—the DHS office is located at 128 Serral Drive, Greeneville, TN 37745-3074
 - Greene County—DHS office phone number is 423-639-6181

2. Getting an Application

- You don't need an appointment to receive an application. If you have one, you may not have to wait as long. To get an application, you can either:
 - Call DHS (423-639-6181) or Greeneville City Schools Coordinated School Health (423-823-2916) and have one sent to you.
OR
 - Pick up one at your local DHS office.
OR
 - Print a TennCare application in English or Spanish from the following web site: <http://www.tennessee.gov/tenncare/mem-apply.html>
OR

3. Giving the Application to DHS

- If you can, have an application filled out to take with you to DHS. Take it when you have your appointment with your DHS worker.

4. Disabilities

- DHS also makes disability determinations. This is done for the Social Security Administration (SSA). These persons may also be eligible for TennCare. To find out more, call 1-800-342-1117.
