

**Are you in need of help under the McKinney-Vento Act?**

Have you and your child(ren) been evicted or lost your home?

Are you and your child(ren) living in a motel, hotel, at a campsite, or a shelter?

Are you and your child(ren) living in a place with no heat, no water, or no electricity? Is it unsafe and not up to code?

Has your family lost housing and are you unable to keep everyone in the same place? Did you need to place your child(ren) temporarily with someone else?

Are you and your child(ren) sleeping in a place not meant for sleeping? This could be a car, the park, a public space, an abandoned building, a storage unit, a garage, a porch, a barn, the street, a bus, a church or a shed?

Are you 14 years or older and not living with a parent or legal guardian? Are you enrolled or asking to enroll in the Greenville Area School District?

Are you a student not living with a parent or legal guardian? The reason may be because you did not want to follow the rules, violence, safety reasons, being abandoned, a parent is in jail, have no money, get thrown out because there was no room, food, or money to take care of you.

Are you sharing housing with others because you lost your housing, are having money troubles, and/or are experiencing safety reasons, or another reason?

Are you staying with friends who live in another district and want your children to continue their education in the Greenville Area School District?
