Higher-Level

- Using story structure.
- Selecting a topic and purpose.
- Keeping the intended audience in mind.
- Monitoring the level of detail.
- Choosing words for effect.
- Monitoring the logical flow of ideas.

Lower-Level

- Forming the letters.
- Spacing the words.
- Spelling high-frequency words.
- Applying phoneme-grapheme mapping while spelling.
(speech sound to letter correspondence)
- Writing in paragraph form.
- Checking for end punctuation.
