

Public Notice

The Hamblen County Board of Education is committed to safeguarding the rights of all students and employees within the school system to learn and work in an environment that is free from all forms of harassment, sexual harassment, and discrimination. In accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, it is the policy of Hamblen County Schools to maintain a learning and working environment that is free from harassment and discrimination of any type. The school system prohibits any form of harassment or discrimination based upon age, religion, disability, race, or national origin. It will be a violation of this policy for any student or employee of the school system to harass or discriminate against a student or an employee through conduct or communication in any form. Persons who believe they have been the victim of harassment or discrimination by a student or an employee of the school system, or any third person with knowledge or belief of conduct that may constitute harassment or discrimination should report the alleged acts immediately to an appropriate school official as designated below:
