

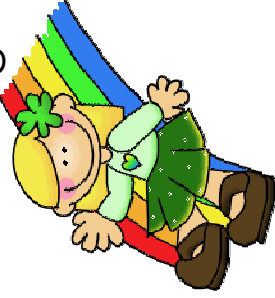
## March Task Card #1

Write an acrostic poem using the word MARCH. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



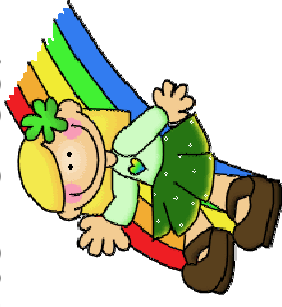
## March Task Card #3

Write the word March at the top of a piece of paper. Use the letters to make new words. Try to make at least 5 new words. Use those words in a sentence.



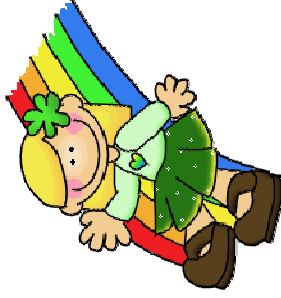
## March Task Card #4

Pretend you are a leprechaun who lost their pot of gold. Write about what you are going to do to find it.



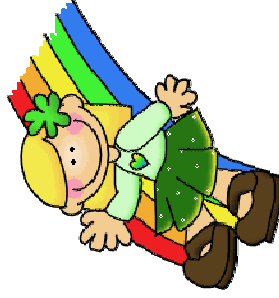
## March Task Card #5

Spring officially begins this month. Does it feel like Spring to you. Why or why not?



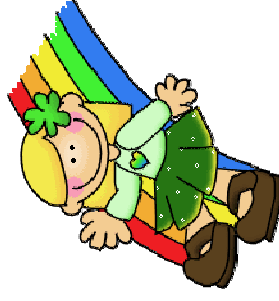
## March Task Card #6

March is Youth Art month. Write about your favorite art activity. Example drawing, coloring, painting or working with clay.



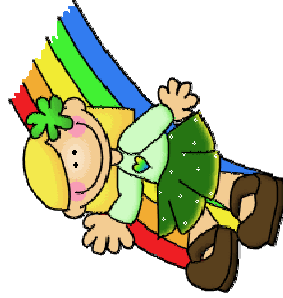
## March Task Card #9

March is National Nutrition month. Write about why it's important to eat healthy.



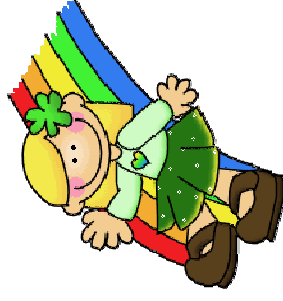
## March Task Card #11
