Feeding will go as follows:

Curbside feeding will Start at 10:00am End at 10:15am

Student must pick up their meal at their enrolled school

- Bowling Green Elementary – Front of school at Front Office entrance
- Hilltop Elementary- Front of school at Front Office entrance
- Hardee Junior High –Parent pick-up area gate will open at 10:00 am gate will close at 10:30 am Follow the HILO sign
- North Wauchula- Parent pick-up in the front of school
- Wauchula Elementary- Parent pick-up at the front of the school
- Hardee Senior High- Parent pick-up in front of the school at Front Office entrance
- Zolfo Elementary- Parent pick-up in front of the school at Front Office entrance

Serving Days: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday

The menu will be posted on each school website

- Click on lunchroom
- Select Access Meal Viewer, click on accept
- Top of the page two-tabs Breakfast and Lunch.

The meal that will be packed will be the main menu item listed first under entrée.

Menu is subject to change due to availability.

Elementary: You will receive Entrée of the day, 1/2 cup of fruit, 1/2 cup of vegetables and choice of milk.

Middle and High School: You will receive Entrée of the day, 1 cup of fruit, 1 cup of vegetables and choice of milk

Food Service will not be serving meals on Scheduled days off and Holidays.

Meals are for enrolled students only and must be picked up at their brick and mortar zoned school.

Student must be enrolled in Hardee County Schools. Cashier must be able to look up the name of student and verify that child is enrolled in the Hardee County School system.

Student must be in the car with parent.

Student must speak their full name and/or Student ID; Cashier will scan roster into point of sale to verify. If child does not come up in system. The parent will be asked to wait until cashier receives verification that the child is enrolled in Hardee District Schools.

Child must speak what flavor milk they would like with their Lunch and Breakfast.

Food service assistant will put a Lunch for the day and Breakfast for the following day on a cart. At that time the parent, will pick-up the meal. Then move forward.

Food Service staff will be wearing facemask, gloves and face shields.
