Background Disqualification
Criminal Records including Guilty Pleas (Regardless of Adjudication),
No Contest Pleas, Pre-trial Intervention/Diversion.

The following crimes constitute a status of immediate disqualification of a vendor/contractor or their employees. Note that: **A non-instructional contractor convicted of any of the offenses listed below and is found on school grounds commits a third degree felony.**
