
**Subject:** Milk Products Bid

**Background Information:** In the 2009-2010 school year we piggybacked the Polk County Dairy Products Bid. We recommend approval to continue to piggy-back the Polk County Dairy Products Bid 006-PLA-0708, which was negotiated with Velda Farms, for the 2010-2011 school year.
