Dear Harlandale Family Member;

The Harlandale ISD continues to move forward to offer courses that connect directly with college and high paying jobs for our students. That's why we say: "The future starts here!" We welcome Dr. Eddie Rodriguez, who will serve as Principal of the Early College High School, which is set to open in the fall of 2014. The new high school will offer a variety of courses geared for high school students with a clearly defined pathway through community college while on their way to completing their college education in a university setting. Courses offered will provide students more opportunities to earn an Associate's Degree and/or additional credits for college by partnering with the Alamo Colleges and Texas A&M-San Antonio. Students will be offered a variety of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) courses; focused training in Health Careers, and studies will be available in a variety of fields including oil, natural gas, and environmental industries.

The first day of school will be August 26th. All students enrolling in the Harlandale district next school year will be required by state law to show proof of residency and comply with the No Shots, No School policy. New students enrolling in the district will be required to provide proof of residency, a birth certificate, immunization records, a social security card, and their latest report card. Parents or guardians must provide a photo ID. Immunization records can be obtained at the Mission Branch library now through August 30th. A list of locations for shots and sports physicals, and a list of school supplies can be found on the back-to-school link on the district website.

The district is currently accepting nominations for the annual Harlandale ISD Hall of Fame. The deadline to submit a completed nomination form is Friday, August 30, 2013 at 4:30 p.m. The application is available on our website.
