TN Summer EBT for Kids

Starting in May 2018 and continuing through August 2018, selected families with eligible school-aged children will be given Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer for Kids, or *Summer EBT for Kids* cards. The cards will be delivered to eligible homes in May, loaded with \$30 per eligible child to spend on food for children. Additional funds will be loaded on the card each month. There is no need to sign up. A child's eligibility is determined by the child's school and participation in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. Tennessee Summer EBT Cards can be used in any store or farmers market authorized to accept SNAP/Food Stamp benefits to purchase food for your child(ren).
