

ADMISSION POLICY

Junior High and High School Admissions Procedures:

- 1. An interview will be held, preferably with parent(s) and the prospective student.
- 2. A copy of the prospective student's most recent achievement test scores and report card must be furnished.
- 3. Reason(s) for the student's withdrawing from the previous school must be put in writing.
- 4. The student's record must verify acceptable academic performance.
- 5. The prospective student must have acceptable deportment.
- 6. Heritage Academy does not accept a student who has been suspended and/or expelled from another school.
- 7. Heritage Academy test students for admission and placement for grades 1 8.
- 8. Falsifying any admissions documents will cause the student to be denied admission to Heritage Academy.
- 9. The Admissions Committee of Heritage Academy shall approve all applications for admission prior to enrollment.
