What is the Hoover City Schools Foundation?

The Hoover City Schools Foundation is a charitable, non-profit organization created to support Hoover City Schools by funding enhanced academics through teacher grants, scholarships, and programs designed to prepare students for successful future careers that meet current industry needs.

What is the purpose of the Student Board?

The Hoover City Schools Foundation is seeking Hoover High School and Spain Park High School students to serve as ambassadors of the organization. Student Board members will be expected to represent the HCSF at various functions and events, assist the HCSF in supporting Hoover City Schools by offering community service efforts, and will be responsible for reaching out to donors and thanking them for their contributions.

What are the requirements to serve on the HCSF Student Board?

The Hoover City Schools Foundation is seeking reliable high school students with excellent communication skills, poise, a servant attitude and exceptional character traits. An interview will be conducted to determine these qualities. Additionally, to apply for the HCSF Student Board, students must turn in a completed application, two completed recommendation forms (preferably from teachers or school administrators), and their most recent report card showing a C average or higher. Students on the board must maintain a C average, attend all board meetings unless formally excused, fulfill community service requirements and be present at 3 or more designated functions or events throughout their term. Failure to maintain requirements may result in dismissal from the HCSF Student Board.

Students from any high school grade level at Hoover High School, Spain Park High School or Crossroads may apply. The HCSF will be accepting four Freshman (Junior Board Members) and up to 16 Sophomores, Juniors and/or Seniors to serve on the Student Board in the 2014-15 School Year.
