Summer Meal Program for Children Seeks Community Sites

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County School Nutrition Program (SNP) will offer its annual summer feeding program in cooperation with the Georgia Department of Education this June and July. Meals will be offered free of charge to children ages 18 and under, Monday through Friday, May 28 through July 26, 2019. Organizations offering summer programs for children may be eligible to participate in this program and receive meals at no charge for participants. Interested organizations must apply and be approved by **April 22, 2019**.

Vacation Bible Schools, athletic practices, scout troops, recreation departments and tutoring programs are examples of the many summer programs which may be eligible to receive meals free of charge to serve children attending their programs and activities. Huntington Middle School, Morningside Elementary School and Parkwood Elementary School will be open for the approved sites to pick up meals. (Although Northside High School has traditionally served as a pick up site, it will not be a site this summer due to a kitchen renovation.)
