Houston County High Senior Signs with University of AZ March 19



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA - Houston County High School senior Jordan Kozloski will sign her letter of intent with the University of Arizona (UA) on **March 19, 2019, at 3:00 p.m.** She will join the UA adaptive athletics program as a basketball player.

Kozloski has been a member of the Houston County Sharks since second grade, when the adapted sports team was formed the summer of 2008. At graduation this May, she will have played wheelchair basketball, football and handball for the Sharks varsity team for 11 years. During her tenure, the team has won 23 state championships and several other state-level awards.

The UA Adaptive Athletics Program offers students the chance to compete nationwide and internationally against world-class athletes and provides access to training, practice facilities and campus staff. Established in 1975, it is the largest collegiate based program in the nation. The university has six globally competitive teams, six national championships and 38 Paralympians.

The signing event will be held in the Houston County High cafeteria. The school is located at 920 Highway 96 in Warner Robins. Dr. Doug Rizer serves as principal.
