Houston County High Senior Chosen as Georgia's Most Positive Adapted Sports Athlete



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Houston County High School senior Jordan Kozloski has been named the Most Positive Adapted Sports Athlete in the State of Georgia. She will be honored at the 2018-19 Georgia Positive Athlete awards on June 4 at 7:15 p.m. at the College Football Hall of Fame in Atlanta.

The lead spokesperson for Positive Athlete, Hines Ward, a former wide receiver for the Pittsburgh Steelers and University of Georgia Bulldogs, will recognize the honorees. Each state-wide winner will receive a Positive Athlete shirt signed by Hines, a certificate and an opportunity to take photos with Hines and other celebrities in attendance.

Kozloski has been a member of the Houston County Sharks since second grade, when the adapted sports team was formed the summer of 2008. At graduation this May, she will have played wheelchair basketball, football and handball for the Sharks varsity team for 11 years. During her tenure, the team has won 23 state championships and several other state-level awards.

Kozloski participated in the school district's [13 Reasons Why Not](#) video series, a campaign about hope and resiliency. Learn more about her story by watching her video, "The Way I Look Does Not Define Me."

She qualified for the state award after winning the Middle Ga. Region Adapted Sports award. In addition, on March 19, she signed her letter of intent with the University of Arizona (UA) to play basketball with the UA adaptive athletics program.
