Summer Meals Offered for Children

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County School Nutrition Program will continue operations this summer, offering meals free of charge to children ages 18 and under, Monday through Friday, May 28 - July 26, 2019. Children do not need to be enrolled in the Houston County School System to receive meals.

Meals are offered at three schools: Huntington Middle, Morningside Elementary and Parkwood Elementary. Breakfast is served 7:30 to 9:30 a.m. Lunch is served 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (Although Northside High has traditionally served as a pick up site, it will not be a site this summer due to a kitchen renovation.)

In addition, seven mobile routes will travel scheduled routes through Houston County neighborhoods to serve children who are unable to access one of the school sites. Additional sites, such as Vacation Bible Schools at participating churches, will be opened periodically throughout the summer. All sites are able to serve any child up to 18 years of age.
