School Groundbreaking Ceremony June 26

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – A groundbreaking ceremony will be held for a primary school on June 26, 2019, at 8:00 a.m. The new campus is located at 535 Thompson Mill Road in Bonaire. The school will serve students in grades Pre-K through 2. It is projected to open in time to welcome students on Aug. 4, 2020, the first day of the 2020-2021 school year.

The design will be similar to C.B. Watson Primary and Langston Road Elementary. The district's current elementary school prototype was designed by Robertson Loia Roof (RLR) Architects and Engineering. The construction manager for this project is Parrish Construction Group.

Funded by the 2017-2022 Education - Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax, the overall budget is approximately \$21 million. The school will have approximately 104,000 square feet with an estimated capacity of 925 students.
