Two Houston County High Seniors Named to State Student Advisory Council



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Two Houston County High School seniors have been chosen for State School Superintendent Richard Woods’ 2018-2019 Student Advisory Council. Alexandra Comportie and Maddie Key are among 120 Georgia secondary students chosen to participate.

The students are pictured with their principal, Dr. Doug Rizer, and assistant principal, Jay Jones. The first meeting will be held Oct. 11 at the Georgia Department of Education in Atlanta.

Members were selected from nearly 1,000 applicants based on their answers to essay questions focused on their ideas for public education and involvement in their school and community. Council members will meet four times during the school year to advise Superintendent Woods on how state policies impact the classroom. They will also serve as his ambassadors in their schools.

“Every day, I’m faced with choices that will directly affect Georgia’s kids,” Superintendent Woods said. “Because of the students who serve on this council, I’m better able to make sound, informed decisions. I deeply value their input and involvement.”
