Robotics Team Previews Robot Built for Competition



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County Flying Legion robotics team #3635 is preparing for the annual FIRST Robotics competition. The team consists of high school students who have met for months on weekends and after school to build their robot and prepare for the event.

The students will **demonstrate the robot** on **March 13, 2018**, at the Houston County Career Academy from **4:30 to 7:00 p.m.** The demonstration will be offered to the media before the robot is entered into the contest in Albany. The FIRST Robotics event will take place March 16, 2018.

Last year the team qualified to compete at the world competition, held in Houston, Texas. Since 2011, Houston's Robotics team, the *Flying Legion*, has invited students from all five high schools to participate. The team is led by Northside High physics teacher Tom Stahl, Houston County Career Academy construction teacher Steve Waters and local engineer mentors.

The team will be preview their robot in the Career Academy's Hibbitts Hall. Guests are invited to park in the side lot near Russell Parkway.
